# PIER LURES ART LOVERS

**W**ith over 400 works exhibited, there's something for everyone – from watercolour landscapes through to maths-based computerised fractal art.

"This is the fourth exhibition we've held on the pier and it's really going from strength to strength," says organiser Kath Daintith-Jones. "As well as a strong core of local talent we also attract artists from as far afield as South Wales and Cheshire. The fact it's held on a pier is so unusual and it's great to think we're moving things forward culturally."
